

Oyens & Van Eeghen · Den Bosch





Founded 1779, Bank Oyens & van Eeghen is one of the oldest banks in the Netherlands. The office in Den Bosch is the first establishment besides the head office in Amsterdam. The integrated way of working and the close contact with the clients of Oyens & van Eeghen are reflected in the layout of the office, which comprises a waiting room and places for informal meetings in addition to the offices and meeting rooms.

The black and white concept chosen for the interior creates a distinctly clear and classical basic atmosphere. The lighting and materialisation combined with refined detailing make the perception of the space both dynamic and serene.

This is for example expressed in the contrast between the hardness of the black rubber that covers the floor in the corridor and waiting room, and partially extends into the office and meeting rooms, and the softness of the black carpet in these spaces. This continuity is emphasized by the full-glass walls, which are partially satinized to safeguard the privacy of the clients.

Löhmann's also managed the realization of this project and was responsible for the planning and control of the budget. It was an extra challenge to execute the project from design to realisation in only two months.
