





During the hundred years of its existence, the various inhabitants have again and again adjust the interior of this monumental building according to their needs. All afterward additions have been removed, and the original spatial proportions have been restored to their original spacious layout. By research and analysis of the original architecture, a contemporary interpretation of it has been created, by means of a careful selection of materials and detailing.
